

# The Great Ontario-Hopped Craft Beer Competition Checklist

## The Checklist:

Please follow this checklist to ensure you have completed all the required steps and are eligible for the competition.

- Name of brewery and hopyard(s) written clearly on each container tag and hops bag. Tag affixed securely to container (can or bottle) with elastic provided.
- Approximately 30 g (1 oz) of each hop variety used in the beer is sealed in the baggies provided, or grower's packaging, with the variety written clearly on the label and brewery name.
- Inform competition organizers when hops have been delivered to brewer.
- Inform competition organizers when hops have been received by brewer.
- High resolution logos for both the brewery and hopyard(s) have been submitted to the competition organizers. This is free advertising for you on our website and on social media!
- Register for the OFVC if you plan to attend the competition in person: [www.ofvc.ca](http://www.ofvc.ca)
- Containers have no features that might identify the competitors and they are packed securely.

## Where to Ship or Drop-off Entries:

Entries (i.e. containers and hops) can be dropped off or shipped to the following address to be held for the competition no later than 16:00, Thursday, February 13<sup>th</sup>:

Alternately, entries (i.e. containers and hops) can be dropped off at the competition kiosk at the Scotiabank Convention Centre (6815 Stanley Avenue, Niagara Falls) on Tuesday, February 18<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 10:00 and 15:00. The kiosk will be clearly marked and located in the Receiving Hall outside the tradeshow floor. DO NOT leave your entry with anyone at the Scotia Bank Convention Centre except a member of the competition team.

If complete entries (i.e. containers and hops) are not received by organizers by the February 18<sup>th</sup> 15:00 cut off, the entry will not be eligible for the competition. There will be no exceptions for any reason.

Judging will take place on February 19<sup>th</sup> at the Ontario Fruit and Vegetable Convention, Scotiabank Convention Centre, Niagara Falls, Ontario. 6815 Stanley Avenue, Niagara Falls.
